FELLOWSHIP

1. KOINOYNIA (koinwniva , (2842)), (*a*) communion, fellowship, sharing in common (from *koinos*, common), is translated “communion” in 1 Cor. 10:16; Philm. 6, R.V., “fellowship,” for A.V., “communication;” it is most frequently translated “fellowship;” (*b*) that which is the outcome of fellowship, a contribution, e.g., Rom. 15:26; 2 Cor. 8:4.
