An essential part of God's character

- "Father of the fatherless and protector of widows is God in his holy habitation" (Psalm 68:5).
- "You shall not mistreat any widow or fatherless child" (Exod. 22:22).
- "Religion that is pure and undefiled before God the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep oneself unstained from the world" (James 1:27).

An essential part of the Gospel

- Through <u>Christ</u>, it is possible for <u>us</u> to become God's children.
- 1. As being "born again" (John 1:12-13; 3:3; 1 Pet. 1:3).
- 2. As being "adopted" (Rom. 8:14-17; Gal. 4:4-7).

- 3. Adoption creates a new familial spirit.
- 4. Adoption overcomes cultural divides.
- 5. Adoption glorifies God.
