
⑤ Now, let's give the background to the **TEXT** ...



**FIRST**, let's consider some things ...

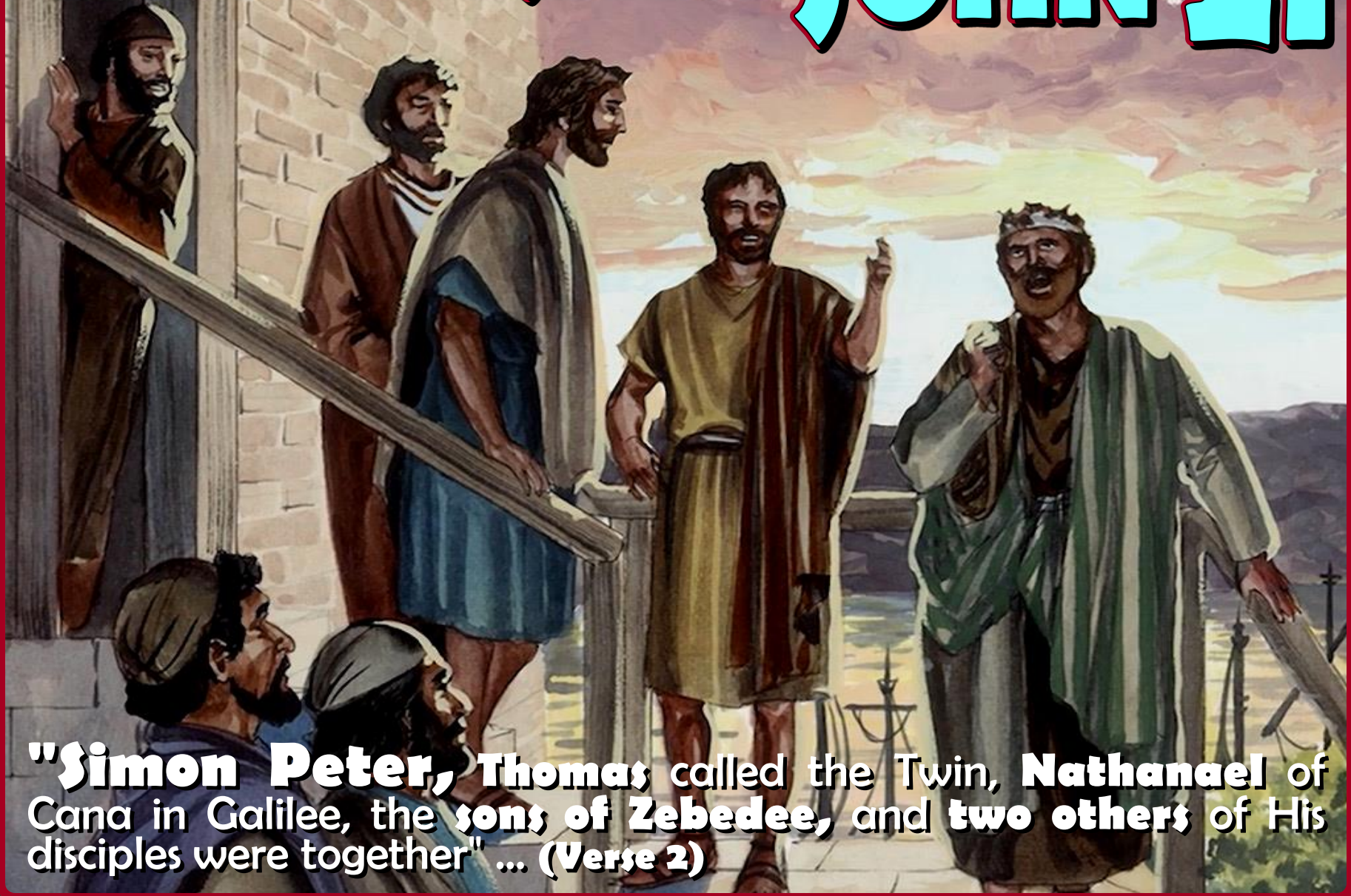
- 1)** What about the **relationship** of this chapter to the **Book of John**,

# The Events of - JOHN 21

# The Events of - JOHN 21



**"Simon Peter, Thomas called the Twin, Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two others of His disciples were together" ... (Verse 2)**

# The Events of - JOHN 21



**"Simon Peter** said to them, **"I am going fishing."** They said to him, **"We are going with you also."** They went out and immediately got into the boat, and **that night they caught nothing"** ... (Verse 3)

# The Events of - JOHN 21



**"But when the morning had now come, Jesus stood on the shore; yet the disciples did not know that it was Jesus" ... (Verse 4)**

# The Events of - JOHN 21



"Then **Jesus** said to them, "**Children, have you any food?**"  
They answered Him, "**No**" ... (Verse 5)

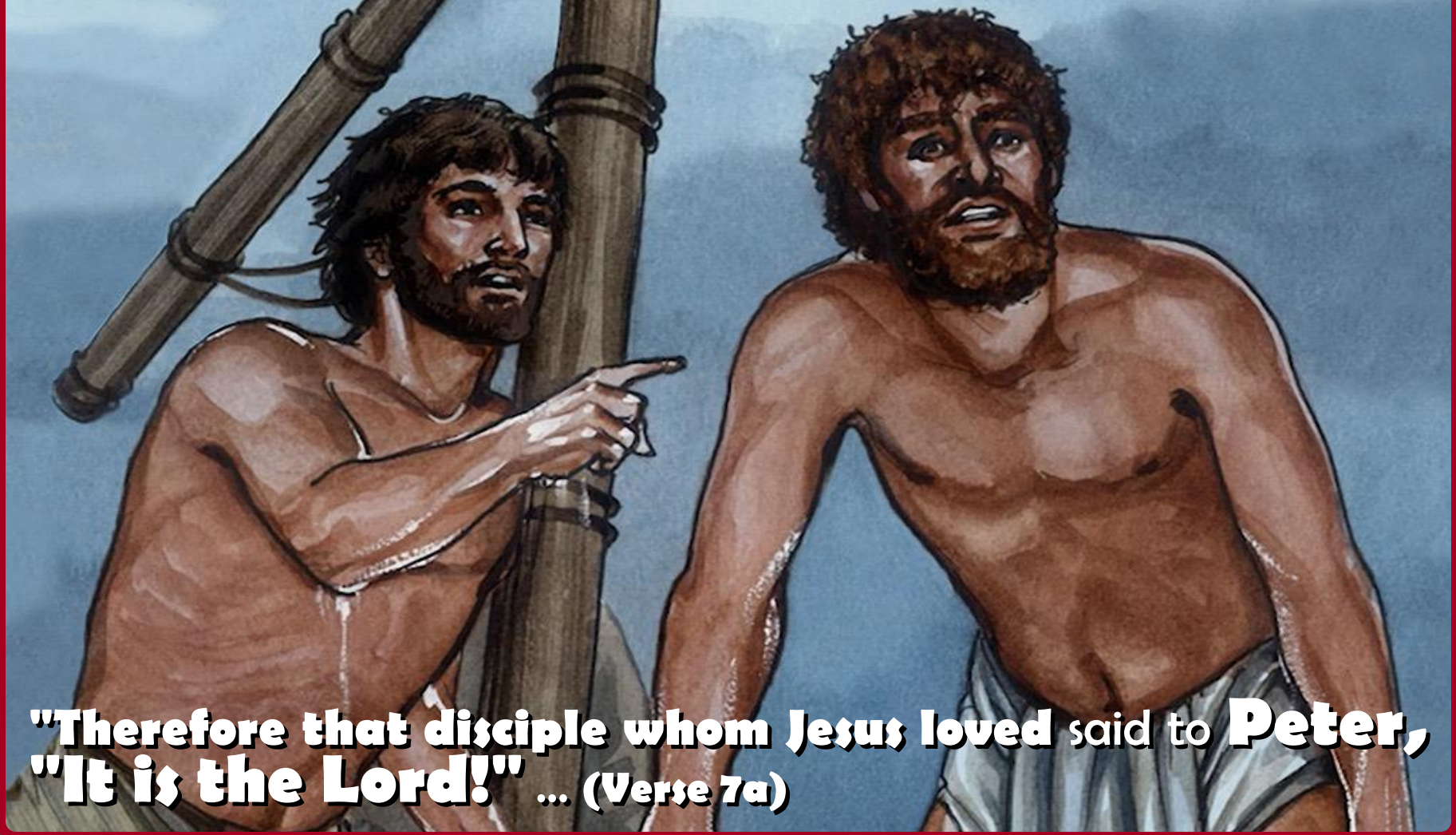


# The Events of - JOHN 21



"And **He** said to them, "**Cast the net on the right side of the boat, and you will find some.**" So they cast, and now they were not able to draw it in because of the multitude of fish" ... (Verse 6)

# The Events of - JOHN 21



**"Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter,  
"It is the Lord!" ... (Verse 7a)**

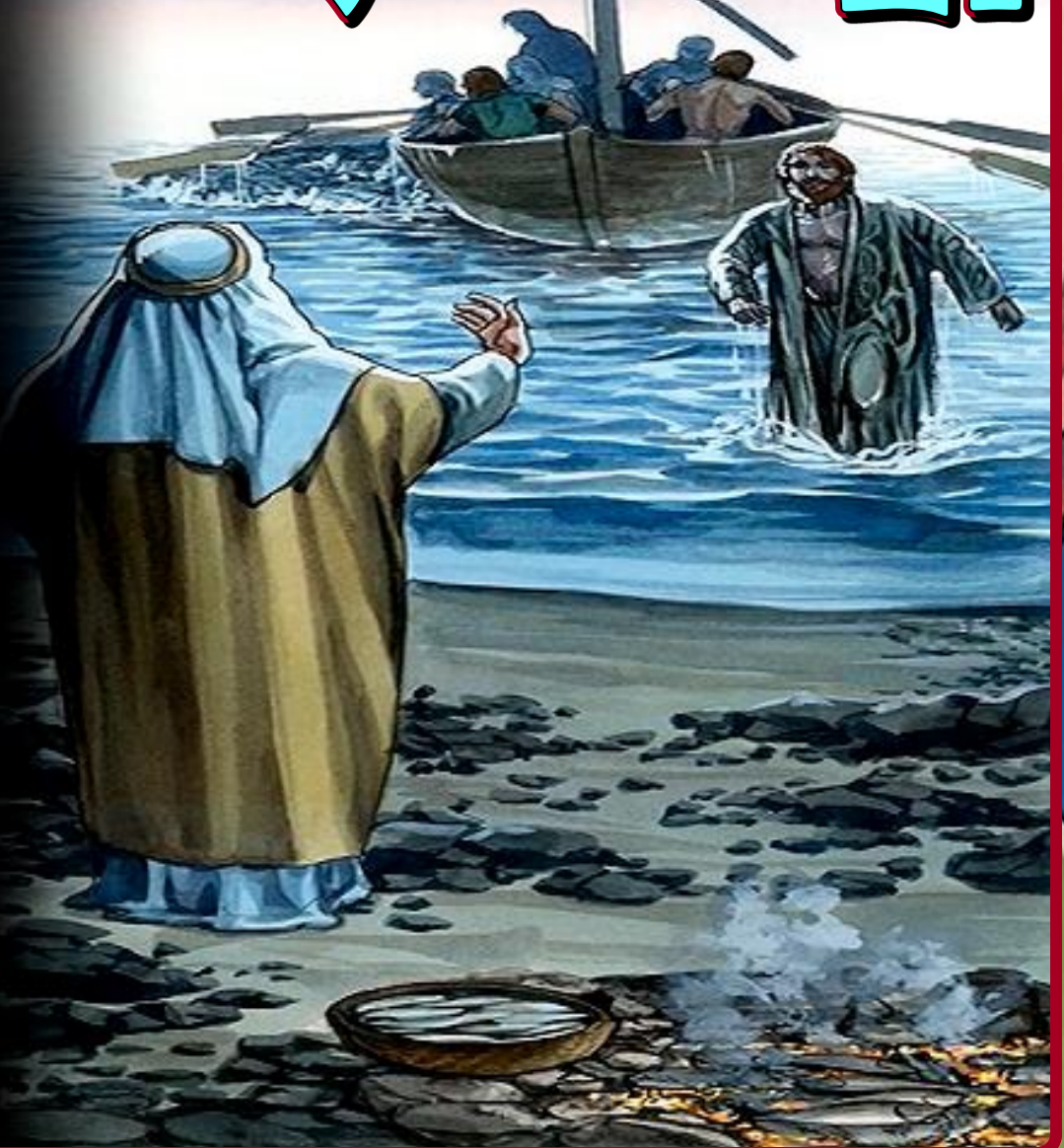
# The Events of - JOHN 21



**"Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on his outer garment (for he had removed it), and plunged into the sea" ... (Verse 7b)**

# The Events of - JOHN 21

**"But the other disciples came in the little boat (for they were not far from land, but about two hundred cubits), dragging the net with fish. <sup>9</sup> Then, as soon as they had come to land, they saw a fire of coals there, and fish laid on it, and bread. <sup>10</sup> Jesus said to them, "Bring some of the fish which you have just caught" ... (Verses 8-10)**

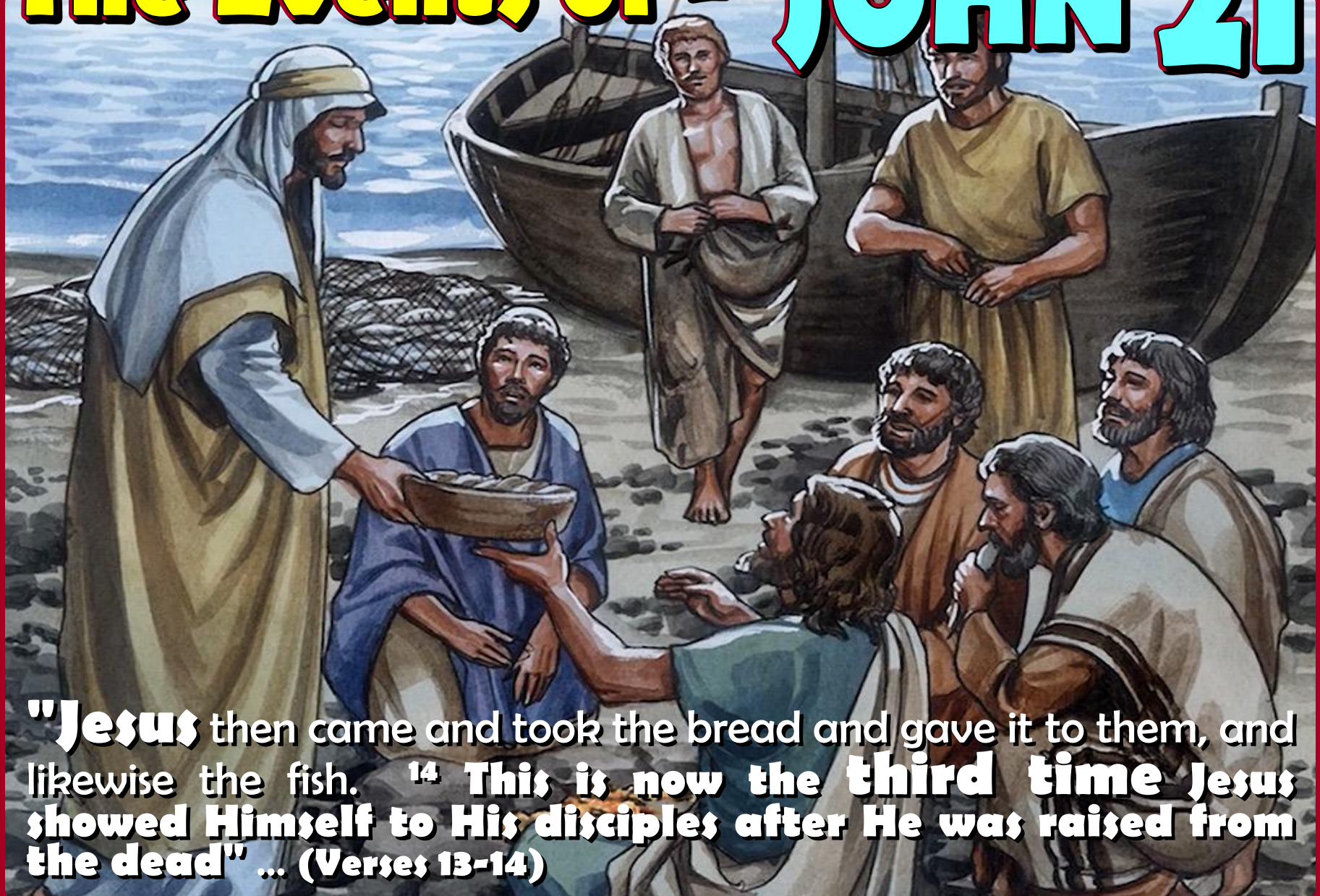


# The Events of - JOHN 21



**"Simon Peter went up and dragged the net to land, full of large fish, one hundred and fifty-three; and although there were so many, the net was not broken. <sup>12</sup> Jesus said to them, "Come and eat breakfast." Yet none of the disciples dared ask Him, "Who are You?" - knowing that it was the Lord" ... (Verses 11-12)**

# The Events of - JOHN 21



**"Jesus** then came and took the bread and gave it to them, and likewise the fish. <sup>14</sup> **This is now the third time Jesus showed Himself to His disciples after He was raised from the dead"** ... (Verses 13-14)

# The Events of - JOHN 21



"So when they had eaten breakfast, **Jesus** said to **Simon Peter**, "**Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me more than these?**" He said to Him, "**Yes, Lord; You know that I love You**" ... (Verse 15a)

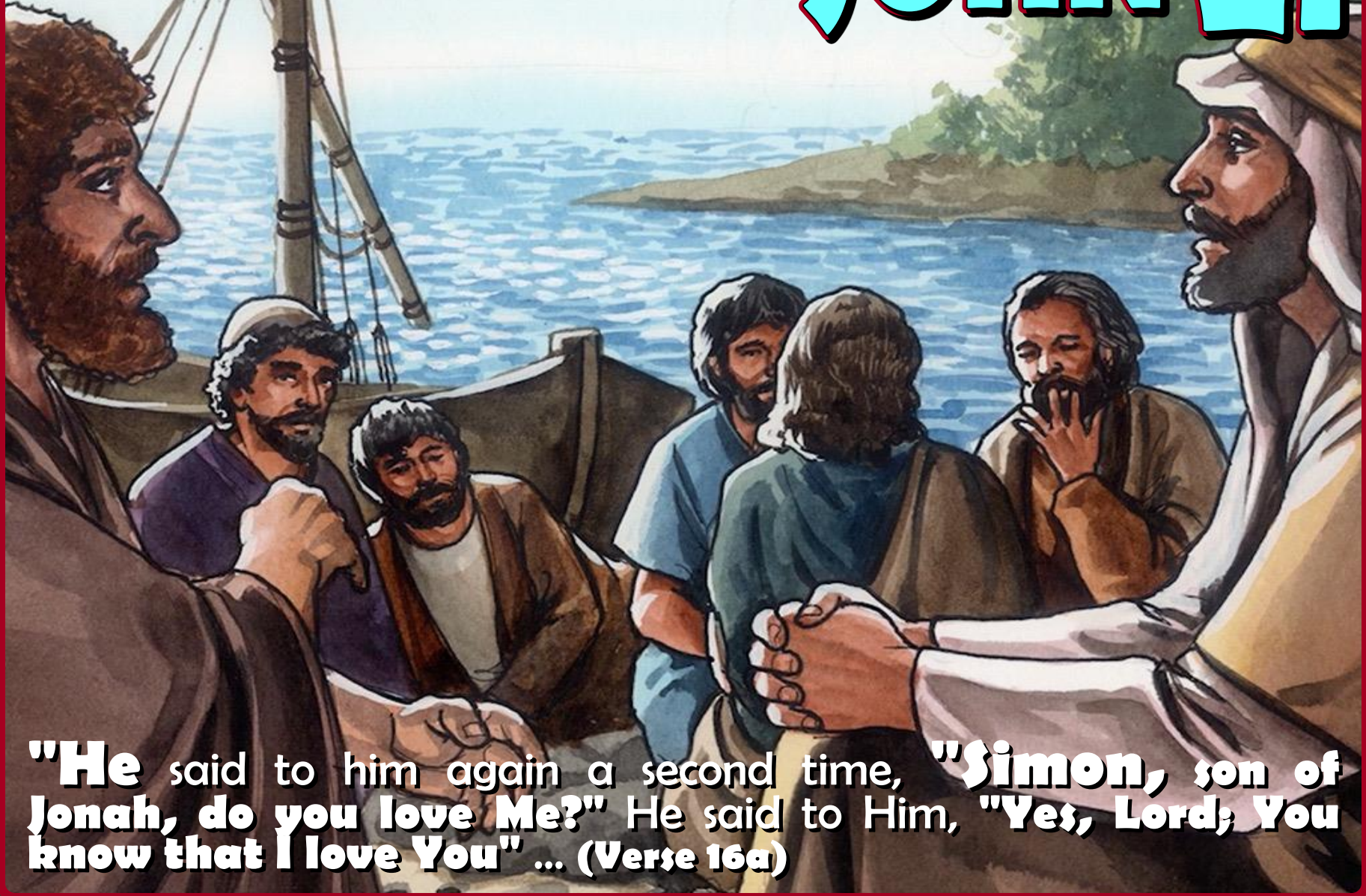
# The Events of - JOHN 21



**"He said to him, "Feed My lambs" ... (Verse 15b)**



# The Events of - JOHN 21



**"He** said to him again a second time, **"Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me?"** He said to Him, **"Yes, Lord; You know that I love You"** ... (Verse 16a)

# The Events of - JOHN 21



**"He said to him, "Tend My sheep" ... (Verse 16b)**

# The Events of - JOHN 21



**"He** said to him the third time, **"Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me?" Peter** was grieved because He said to him the third time, "Do you love Me?" And he said to Him, **"Lord, You know all things; You know that I love You"** ... (Verse 17a)

**"Jesus said to him, "Feed My sheep" ... (Verse 17b)**

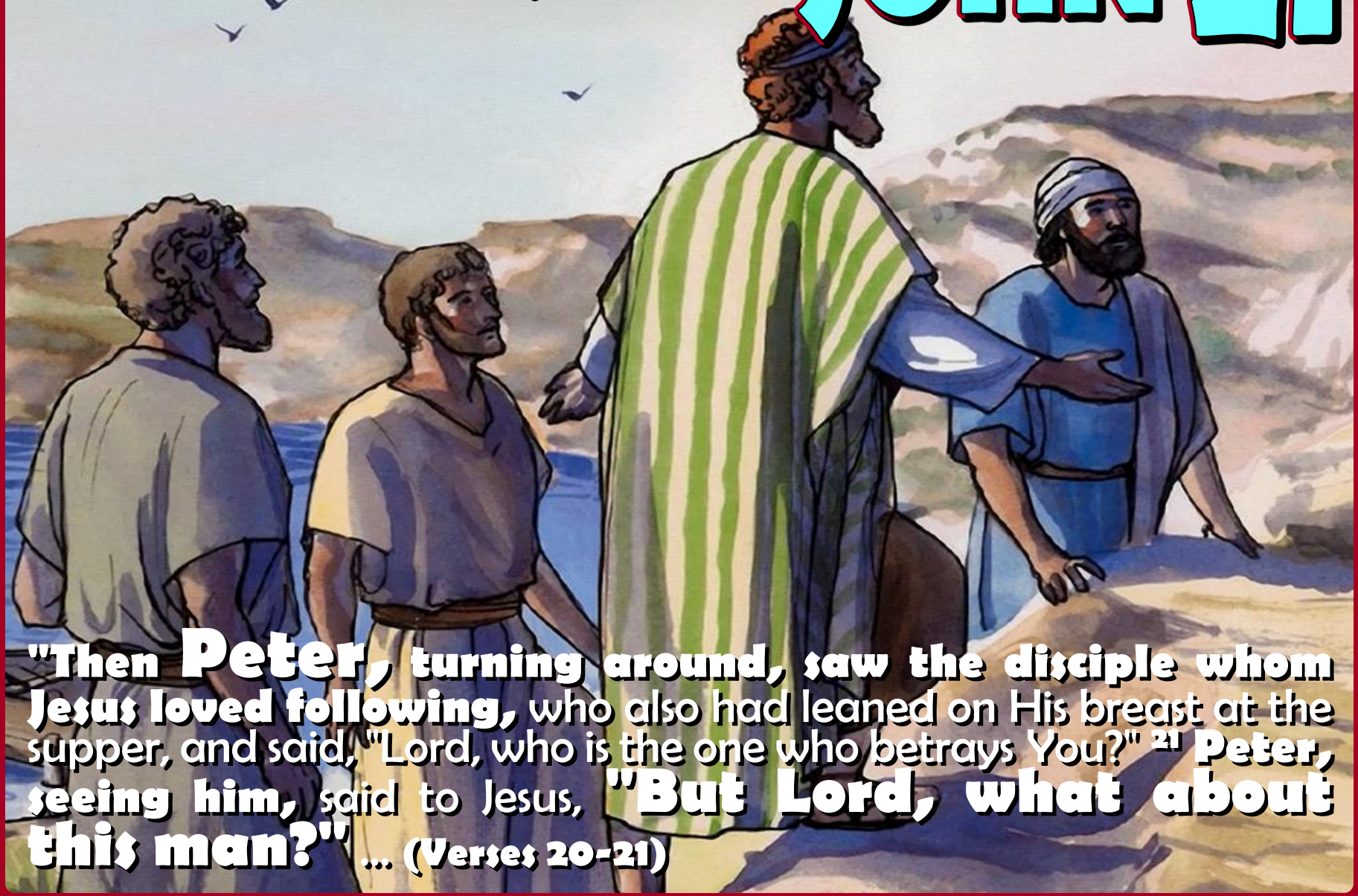



# The Events of - JOHN 21



**"Jesus** said to him, **"If I will that he remain till I come, what is that to you? You follow Me."** <sup>23</sup> Then this saying went out among the brethren that this disciple would not die. Yet Jesus did not say to him that he would not die, but, **"If I will that he remain till I come, what is that to you?"** ... (Verses 22-23)

## Acts 12:1-7

**1** Now about that time Herod the king stretched out his hand to harass some from the church.

**2** Then he killed James the brother of John with the sword.

**3** And because he saw that it pleased the Jews, he proceeded further to seize Peter also. Now it was during the Days of Unleavened Bread.

**4** So when he had arrested him, he put him in prison, and delivered him to four squads of soldiers to keep him, intending to bring him before the people after Passover.

**5** Peter was therefore kept in prison, but constant prayer was offered to God for him by the church.

**6** And when Herod was about to bring him out, that night Peter was sleeping, bound with two chains between two soldiers; and the guards before the door were keeping the prison.

**7** Now behold, an angel of the Lord stood by him, and a light shone in the prison; and he struck Peter on the side and raised him up, saying, "Arise quickly!" And his chains fell off his hands.

## **II Peter 1:12-15**

**12** For this reason I will not be negligent to remind you always of these things, though you know and are established in the present truth.

**Jesus Christ showed**

**me.**

## **Matthew 11:1-6**

**1** Now it came to pass, when Jesus finished commanding His twelve disciples, that He departed from there to teach and to preach in their cities.

**2** And when **John** had heard in prison about the works of Christ, he sent two of his disciples

**3** and said to Him, "**Are You the Coming One, or do we look for another?**"

**4** **Jesus** answered and said to them, "**Go and tell John the things which you hear and see:**

**5** "**The blind see and the lame walk; the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear; the dead are raised up and the poor have the gospel preached to them.**

**6** "**And blessed is he who is not offended because of Me.**"

## **Acts 8:34-38**

## **II Peter 3:15-18**

**15** and consider that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation - **as also our beloved brother Paul, according to the wisdom given to him, has written to you,**

**16** as also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things, **in which are some things hard to understand, which untaught and unstable people twist to their own destruction, as they do also the rest of the Scriptures.**

**17** You therefore, beloved, since you know this beforehand, **beware** lest you also fall from your own steadfastness, being led away with the error of the wicked;

**18** but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory both now and forever. Amen.

## **1 Peter 2:18-21**

**18 Servants, be submissive to your masters with all fear, not only to the good and gentle, but also to the harsh.**

**19 For this is commendable, if because of conscience toward God one endures grief, suffering wrongfully.**

**20 For what credit is it if, when you are beaten for your faults, you take it patiently? But when you do good and suffer, if you take it patiently, this is commendable before God.**

**21 For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps:**

## **1 Peter 4:14-19**

**15 But let none of you suffer as a murderer, a thief, an evildoer, or as a busybody in other people's matters.**

**16 Yet if anyone suffers as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in this matter.**

**17** For the time has come for judgment to begin at the house of God; and if it begins with us first, what will be the end of those who do not obey the gospel of God?

**18** Now "If the righteous one is scarcely saved, Where will the ungodly and the sinner appear?"

**19 Therefore let those who suffer according to the will of God commit their souls to Him in doing good, as to a faithful Creator.**

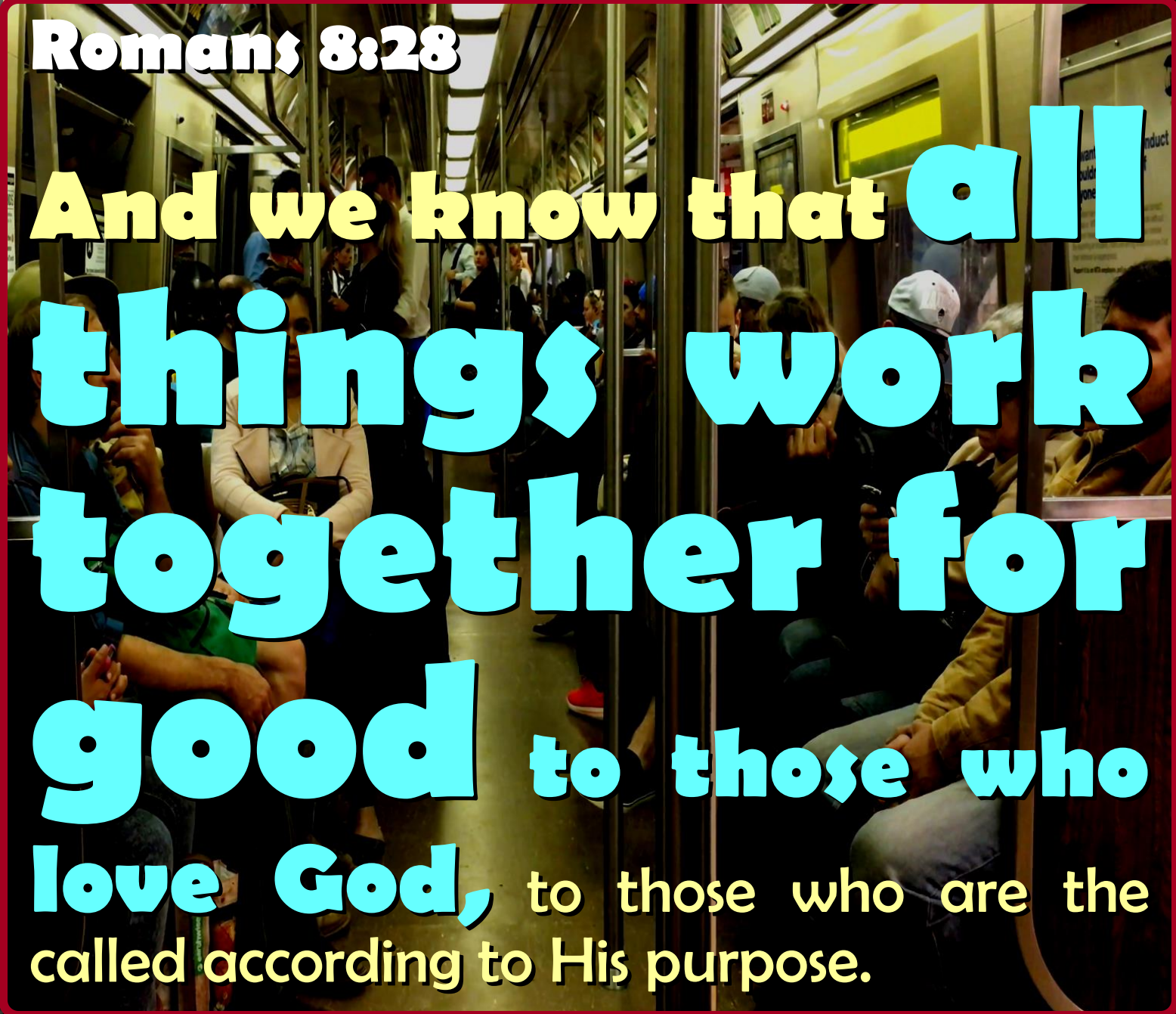
