1. Life under the sun is vanity.

2. Ignoring the vanity of life doesn't make it satisfying.

- Ecclesiastes 2:24-26
- Ecclesiastes 3:9-11

3. Making peace with the vanity of life makes you free to enjoy it.

- Ecclesiastes 3:12-13
- Ecclesiastes 9:7-10; 11:7-10
